



Rules and Regulations

Notice to Holiday House Patrons

West Rockhill-Sellersville Joint Recreation Authority considers the use of Holiday House Recreation Center a revocable privilege and reserves the right to both request the removal and to remove from the premises any person who, in the sole judgement of the management/staff of Holiday House, behaves in a disorderly or otherwise improper manner. Patrons who are displaying signs of contagious disease with symptoms such as: fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, diarrhea, chills repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, and recent loss of taste or smell, will not be admitted to the facility.

1. Badges must be presented to be admitted into the pool. Badges are not transferable. Violators who share badges will be dismissed from the pool for the balance of the season with no refund.
2. Holiday House property is smoke free. Smoking is permitted in the parking lot beyond the pool entrance.
3. Any child, aged 12 and under, must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
4. No running within the fenced-in area of the pool.
5. Rough play is prohibited in and out of the pool area. (Excessive splashing or dunking, hanging on the head, neck, or shoulders, etc. as determined at the discretion of the lifeguards)
6. Foul language is prohibited on all Holiday House Property. (This includes music played from guest devices).
7. No bicycles, skateboards, or shoe skates are permitted on sidewalks or inside of pool areas.
8. Alcohol and firearms are prohibited on all Holiday House property. Patrons who appear to be under the influence of narcotics or alcohol will not be permitted on Holiday House property.
9. Glass containers are NOT allowed on Holiday House property.
10. Swimming suits must be worn in the pool. (No street clothes) T-shirts are acceptable over swimsuits.
11. Children who wear diapers must use approved models and must wear plastic pants over them that are “cinched” at the waist and legs. Accepted plastic pants may be purchased at the pool office.
12. Gum is prohibited within the fenced area of the pool.
13. Soft pool toys, (balls, noodles, etc..) will be allowed in all areas of the pool (except the diving well) at the discretion of the pool staff and must be used in such a manner as not to be a nuisance to other swimmers. No inflatables allowed.
14. The diving well is the only approved diving area and is restricted to the use of the diving board, and rock wall. No swimming is permitted except for treading water during Adult swims.
15. At the first sign of lightning, and/or thunder, all patrons must clear the pool immediately. If, in the opinion of pool staff, the storm is close by, all patrons will be required to leave the fenced in area of the pool and may wait in their cars or in the breeze way. The pool will not re-open until 30 minutes after the last lightning or thunder occurs. The re-opening of the pool is entirely at the discretion of the pool manager.
16. The use of proper flotation devices is permitted **with adult supervision.** See the posted chart for approved types.
17. The use of goggles (that do not cover the nose) is permitted, if used properly.
18. The baby pool is reserved for children under six and their parents.
19. During Adult Swims, only those people 18 years of age or older are permitted in the water (and one child aged 6 or under/ adult.)
20. No chairs are allowed on the pool deck.
21. Individuals under the age of 13 years of age must pass a swim test before they can use the diving board, zip line, or rock wall. Those who pass the test will be issued a wrist band. There is a \$1.00 replacement fee for lost wristbands.
22. Do not block the sprinklers or touch the bucket. No running is permitted anywhere within the fenced in area.
23. Only certified service dogs are allowed in the fenced-in area of the pool and must be leashed.
24. Holiday House staff reserve the right to close the pool at any time due to low attendance, inclement weather, staffing shortages, and private events. No refunds will be given if the facility closes due to the weather. Notice of pool closures will be posted on the pool's Facebook page.
