Mrs. Howells inquired of Perkasie Sargent Mumbauer if there were programs like ride-alongs or P.A.L. so young people get to be positively exposed to police officers. Sargent Mumbauer said they cannot do ride-alongs due to liability concerns but they do have a cadet program.

Ms. Dodson inquired of the manager as to what is done with vehicles that do not adhere to the no parking on emergency evacuation routes during storm events. Manager stated that he requested that the Perkasie Police Chief have the officers at least ticket violators. Sargent Mumbauer stated that approximately eleven tickets were written and one vehicle was towed during the snow storm of January 31-February 2. She further inquired about prioritizing the Lawn Avenue alleys during snow storms.

Mrs. Hallman requested an executive session to discuss personnel matters.
