OLD BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS:

Resolution #2022-04, Zoning Hearing Board:

Ms. Bradley noted that a resume had been received from resident Angela Benner, who was interested in filling a vacancy on the Zoning Hearing Board. Ms. Benner had outstanding experience that made her an excellent candidate for that position, and Ms. Bradley had drafted Resolution #2022-04 in anticipation of a possible appointment.

On motion of Mr. Crouthamel, seconded by Mr. Potoczny, and unanimously approved by all present, to adopt Resolution #2022-04, appointing Angela Benner to the Zoning Hearing Board to fill an unexpired term ending 12/31/2024.

Resolution #2022-05, Designating Disabled Parking:

Ms. Bradley was in receipt of a PennDOT-approved application for a Disabled Parking placard for a resident at 14 W. Grandview Avenue. Proposed Resolution #2022-05

would authorize placement of the appropriate signage in the vicinity of 14 W. Grandview, for use of anyone with the appropriate parking placard.

On motion of Mr. Crouthamel, seconded by Mrs. Hallman, and unanimously approved by all present, Resolution #2022-05 was approved, authorizing Disabled Parking signage to be placed in the vicinity of 14 W. Grandview Avenue.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Incentive Block Grants:

Ms. Bradley questioned the intent of the annual "Incentive Block Grant" for the Sellersville Fire Department and whether Council was interested in continuing the program. Council was in agreement that the program to encourage recruitment and retention of volunteer firefighters was an excellent program. Ms. Bradley would bring the topic forward at a future meeting.

MS Walk:

Ms. Bradley stated that a charity walk was being scheduled to raise funds for Multiple Sclerosis. The Walk would take place in Lake Lenape Park in both Sellersville and Perkasio.
