Volunteers would clean up various locations: municipal parking lots, Train Station Parking Lot, Druckenmiller Playground, and any streets that may need extra attention. The Police Department had been notified about the event. The American Legion offered to bring refreshments after the event.

Mrs. Hallman asked if Council would be holding the May18 Public Management Meeting, as it was Election Day with three Council Members up for reelection. Ms. Bradley would check with Council.
