MINUTES

TRANSFORMATION SKETCH PLAN

Chair Hallman presented the Board with the transformation sketch plan from Derck & Edson that gave a potential plan to improve the former Penn Pants lot adjacent to Druckenmiller Playground. Board members were in agreement that more parking was needed and another pavilion was not.

FAIRY DOOR EVENT

The Park and Recreation Committee discussed the fairy door event, held Sunday May 6th and determined it to be a success and will be done again next year.

CONCERTS IN THE PARK

The Park and Recreation Board briefly discussed the potential to host concerts in the park, but the idea was not supported.

BOUNCE HOUSE FOR PARTY IN PLAYGROUND

The Borough had been asked by a patron if a bounce house could be set up in the playground near the pavilion for a child's party. Board consensus was if the bounce house was set up by the company that owns it and they provided insurance, it was allowed.

LOG BARRICADES

The Borough had been asked by the disc golfers if they could place logs on the perimeter of the disc golf course next to the little league baseball fields to prevent vehicles from parking in the range. Board consensus was to allow them to do place the log barricades.

MURALS

The Borough has been approached by Tim Gibson from Perkasio to participate in a nationwide mural project called Ten Thousand Flowers. Possible sites include the railroad underpass on Maple Avenue and the softball field dugouts in Druckenmiller Playground.
