Mrs. Hallman, Mrs. Boston, and Ms. Gibat had all volunteered to plant flowers for Parks and Recreation. They also organized a day for them to continue planting and dumping old flowerpots.

Mrs. Hallman gave Mrs. Boston and Ms. Gibat scripts for the 32nd National Bell Ringing Ceremony that they agreed to take part in. Ms. Tremmel and Ms. Gibat discussed how to become a bell ringer.

Mrs. Hallman reminded everyone that the June 9th Parks and Rec meeting is also the annual Parks and Rec Picnic, and has everyone sign up to bring a food item.
