MINUTES

Ms. J. MacKenzie made a motion that the minutes of the June 4, 2019 meeting be approved. Motion was seconded by A. Buck and the motion carried with all in favor.

LABYRINTH

Claudine Schuster reviewed plans to install a labyrinth in the park land next to the National Guard Armory. The plans include planting between 75 - 100 boxwoods and arborvitae. She and her husband would install and maintain the labyrinth. Park & Recreation members visited the site where Ms. Schuster and her husband had marked off the area to be developed. J. MacKenzie moved to approve the labyrinth installation. Motion was seconded by A. Buck and approved with all in favor.

FIVE YEAR PLAN

Chair Hallman stated that a part of the Revitalization Committee recommendation for improvements to the borough, is for the Parks and Recreation Committee to develop a Five Year Plan for improvements to the park and playground. Some of the suggestions include additional walking paths around the Veteran's Memorial and towards the lake; gardens; install a pond by the little league fields; new playground equipment; new Christmas tree; replace lights at tennis courts; enlist volunteers to clean-up park and add more hammocks.

HOLIDAY DECORATING AWARDS

Committee discussed ordering the awards to be given out for prizes for the 2019 Holiday Decorating. The Committee decided to go with the teardrop shaped one.

HOLIDAY STREET DECORATIONS

Chair Hallman showed the Committee the two styles of decorations purchased: cascading stars and a snowflake. The decorations are used and require some refurbishing. Mr. Moore took a snowflake home to work on refurbishing it to see how much work is involved.

HALLOWEEN PARTY VS PARADE

Committee discussed the possibility of holding a Halloween Party instead of a parade. Weather has not always made the parade possible and the number of participants has dropped. Some ideas discussed include having it at the Fire Hall with games, a haunted house, decorating pumpkins or masks. The Committee decided to not have trophies this year.

WINTERFEST TROLLEYS

Manager informed Committee that he had received a contract document from Choo Choo Trolley for four trolleys for the Winterfest event, December 3, 2019.
